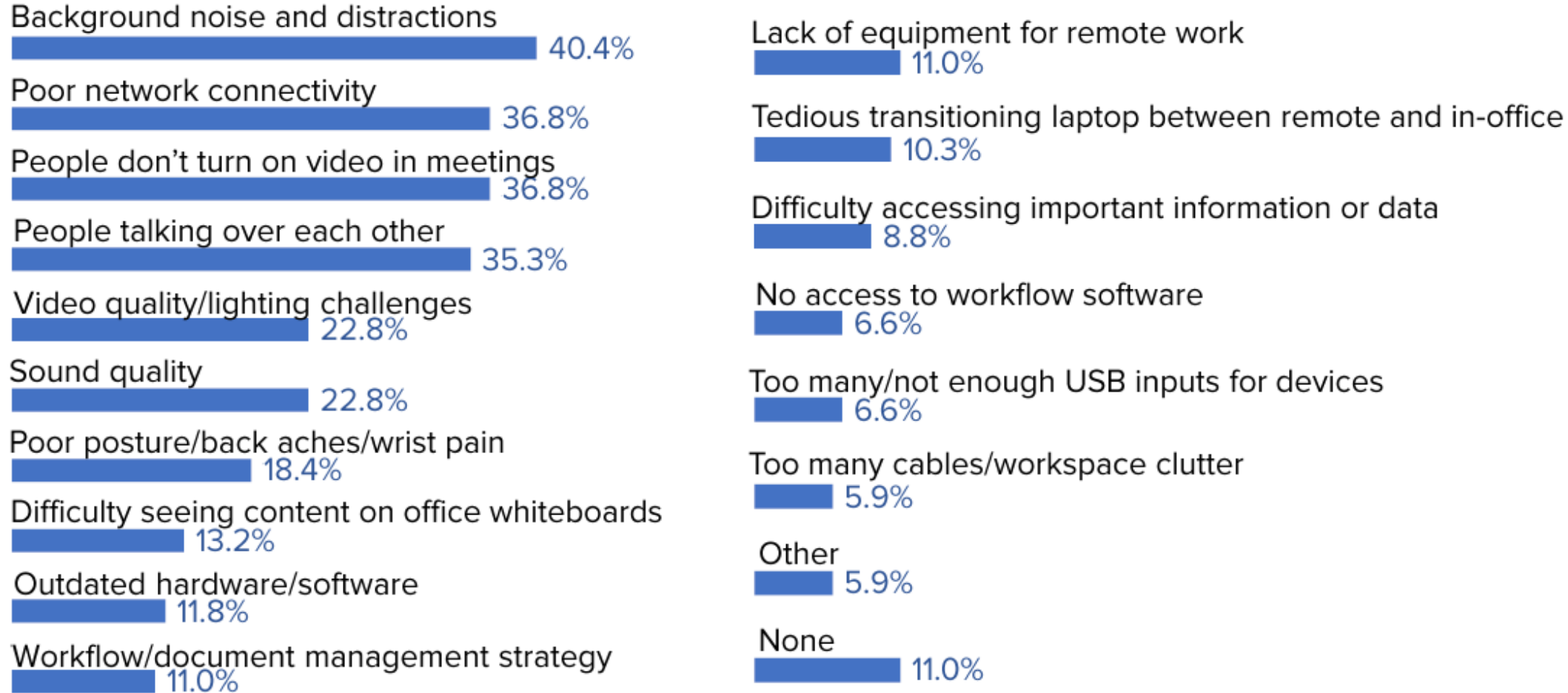
1. Decreased Workplace Culture

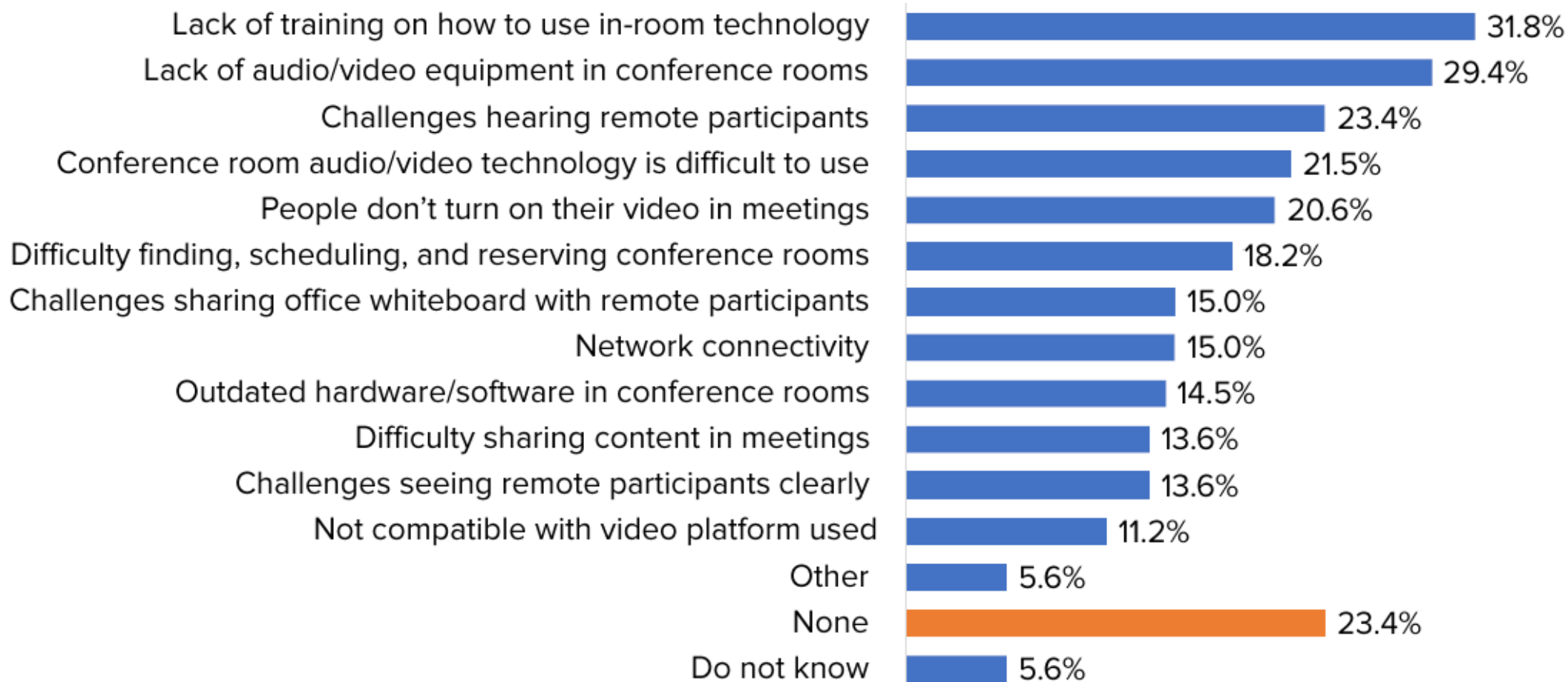
